APPLICATION

- A test patch is recommended before full application.
- · Work in manageable areas at a time.
- · Protect surrounding areas from over-spray etc.

For spot cleaning & degreasing of un-coated exterior surfaces:

- Use neat.
- Apply by brush or cloth a liberal quantity of product to the area. Scrub and rinse thoroughly until foaming stops. Rinsing with a pressure washer is recommended.
- Multiple applications may be required for tough contaminants.
- Allow substrate to completely dry before application of any coatings.
- · Clean all application equipment with water.

For general cleaning of un-coated exterior surfaces:

- Use diluted, 1 part product to 2 parts water.
- · Apply by brush, roller or watering can and gently scrub the surface to loosen dirt and contaminants.
- · After 10 minutes, thoroughly rinse the area until foaming stops. Rinsing with a pressure washer is recommended.
- Multiple applications may be required if surface contaminants remain.
- · Allow substrate to completely dry before application of any coatings.
- Clean all application equipment with water.

For the removal of cured sealer:

- Apply by brush or roller a liberal quantity of un-diluted product to the area. Gently agitate the surface with the brush or roller until the cured sealer re-emulsifies. This will take only a matter of seconds to minutes, dependent upon the age and thickness of the coating being removed.
- Immediately pressure wash the treated area before moving on to the next area. Thoroughly rinse until foaming stops. Remove standing water from the next area of application before applying product.
- If the coating has been applied to internal areas or areas where pressure washing is not practical, remove reemulsified coating with rags and then thoroughly rinse and mop to remove all residues.
- Multiple applications may be required for highly porous surfaces and / or thick sealer applications.
- Continue this process until the entire area has been completed.
- Allow substrate to completely dry before application of any coatings.
- · Clean all application equipment with water.

CLEAN UP

 Wash all equipment in warm water and a small amount of detergent immediately after use.
